 - i. Fall road grading SOW and RFP completed, several interested contractors have visited and inspected roads. Three quotes are expected, including one from MSC.
 - ii. 2026 – 2028 snow plowing SOW and RFP, completed and talking to potential contractors
 - iii. Centennial Financial Management (CMG) contract
 1. Altitude Community Law reviewed and contract revisions completed
 2. Signed revised contract
 3. CMG is new financial management company as of August 1st
 - iv. Burn pit – meeting scheduled next week with JCFD -Trent Smith to determine pit options, an update is expected by August 12, 2026

 - ii. Migration from Clark Miller Simson to CMG
 - 1. Larry is working with both CSM and CFM to transition to new financial management company
 - d. Steve Johnson, at-large
 - iii. Weed spraying
 - 1. County weed spraying, association is responsible for invasive thistle weed control.
 - 2. CSU recommends using Milestone due to safety to livestock and wildlife
 - 3. Board has been properly applying Milestone solution directly to thistles around pond and association roads.
 - 4. Bare areas on pond dam have been seeded with high altitude grass seed
 - iv. Culvert marking, purchased 85 used 6' tee posts from Lazy Bull ranch for \$160. Board will work with volunteers to install at culverts to protect during road grading and snow plowing.
 - v. Signage to be addressed; Michigan Hill, Glacier Peak and "Welcome to Michigan Hill"
 - vi. Augmentation pond
 - 1. Home Owner reports slipping into pond. Board will check into possible solutions
 - 2. Larry pond communication
 - a. Garver Brown, board requested all communications include board members
 - b. Jerry Devries, has been very helpful suppling pond activity and Garver Brown communication in 2026
 - c. Karl Copeman, has not been responsive to board request for willingness to continue pond support. Larry motioned to remove Karl from all pond support, Mike 2nd, board approves unanimously

 - vii. Transfer of 2026 records completed from Larry via records binder
 - viii. Welcome package new owners, completion TBD, no cost to homeowners
